Sport Clearances

All sports will be cleared through Final

Forms only.

Do not give paperwork to the Nurses, Coaches,

Secretaries or Administrators. Do not mail it.

Only upload physicals to final forms.

If having difficulty registering for final forms,

contact Athletics.

Do Not wait until the last minute to try and get

cleared, the nurses **Will Not** be able to handle

last minute clearances.

It is the responsibility of the child and parent to

upload paperwork on final forms.

The Nurses will be in the office from

7:30 am to 2 pm on the following dates:

8/1, 8/3, 8/15, 8/18, 8/21 and 8/22.

Parents:

All kids entering 7th and 12th grade must have the meningococcal vaccine.

Without it, they can't start school.

About the Vaccine:

- It's not a new vaccine. It's been recommended for a decade.
- Most parents already choose to vaccinate their children.
- What's new is that the vaccine will be **required** for school entry as of Sept. 1, 2016.

About Meningococcal Disease:

- It causes **bacterial meningitis** and other serious diseases.
- Teens and young adults are at greater risk.
- It comes on quickly and without warning.
- Its symptoms are similar to the flu.
- Every case of this disease can result in death or long-term disability.

Check with your doctor. Even kids who have had a shot before may need a booster to start school.

School Physicals:

New York State requires all 9th & 11th grade students and new entries to the Sachem District have a physical on file with the school.

If your child has had his/her physical, but has not turned in the physicians form, please do so **as soon as possible**.

Students who have not turned in documentation of a physical will be

examined by the school physician.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS!

****If a Doctor or Specialist requests a student not participate in physical education or sports, the NURSE must receive a note from that doctor before they will be allowed to return to gym or sports****

****If you weren't cleared to play physical education when the school year ended in June, we need the clearance from the Physician to allow you to play or an updated medical note to keep you out in September****

****If a student requires any medications, *even over the counter medications* (Advil, Tylenol...etc.) the Nurse needs a**

prescription from the doctor.

Under NYS Nurse's Laws, the Nurse may not administer any

medications without a prescription.**
