What is the National Technical Honor Society?

Not only do NTHS students embody all the attributes and talent which is in demand today, these students also embrace a clear vision for tomorrow's workforce and their role in it. NTHS understands changes in industry within local communities and on a global scale.

What do I need to do to be accepted for membership into this organization?

In order to be accepted into this NTHS, a student must:

- Have an unweighted GPA of (80) or above.
- Have 2 CTE credits
- Have an average of a (90) in CTE course
- Get one teacher letter of recommendation
- Must attend 5 or more meetings
- Must complete 5 or more hours of community service
- Complete and return the application paper on time
- Attend induction ceremony

What is community Service?

Community service is voluntary, unpaid activities that result in benefit to a person in need. The NTHS will accept service hours from any Career and Technical Service Organization service project; which promote career and technical education. What is the membership dues for the NTHS?

- Complete and return the application paper on time
- Attend induction ceremony
- Members that have completed a total of 5 hours of community service will be eligible for a graduation cord.


