1.a. <u>Approval of Maintenance Agreements between the Sachem Central School District and</u> <u>Apperson Education Products</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the maintenance agreements between Sachem Central School District and Apperson Education Products for district-wide scantron machines which include repairs to restore equipment to proper working order in the event of equipment failure. Apperson shall make adjustments and repairs, and replace parts as deemed appropriate to place equipment in good working condition. The cost is \$9.08 per month for each scantron machine for a total cost not to exceed \$1,600 for the 2009/10 school year. Contract information has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.b. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Music Theatre</u> <u>International (MTI)</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Music Theatre International (MTI) to pay a royalty fee and purchase additional show kit materials at a cost of \$962.50 for the production of Annie Junior at Seneca Middle School. This will be paid by the Music and Fine Arts budget code.

1c. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Lighthouse at</u> <u>Mays Landing</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Lighthouse at Mays Landing as an independent contractor of academic tutoring in accordance with New York Education Law at a rate of \$40.00 per hour per student. This contract shall be in effect from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.d. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and School Annual</u> <u>Publishing Co.</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between the Sachem Central School District and School Annual Publishing Co. to provide Yearbooks for Sagamore Middle School. The cost for this service is \$6,045 for 500 copies to be paid for by the students. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district attorney.

1.e. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Classics on Stage

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Classics on Stage to provide 40 copies and pay a performance royalty fee for the production of The Wonderful Wizard of Oz at Sequoya Middle School. The cost for these services is approximately \$264.00 to be paid through the music department's drama supply code.

1.f. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and United Cerebral</u> <u>Palsy of Greater Suffolk for Receipt of IDEA Flow-Through Funding</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement for receipt of IDEA Flow-Through Funding between Sachem Central School District and United Cerebral Palsy of Greater Suffolk as a special education provider for the 611 and 619 grants. The costs associated are in accordance with the IDEA section 611 and section 619 federal funds consistent with federal and state statutes. The term of this agreement shall be July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

Approval of Donation from SYAG and Lynwood PTA

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to accept with gratitude, the donation of approximately \$23,500 from the Sachem Youth Advisory Group (SYAG) and the Lynwood PTA for the purchase of playground equipment for Lynwood Elementary School.

Approval of Donation – Legislator Beedenbender – Field Trip Transportation

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to accept with gratitude, the donation of \$572 from Legislator Beedenbender to pay for transportation for the Anti-Bias Tolerance Day Field Trip on October 28, 2009 for Samoset Middle School students.

Approval of Uncollectable Debt

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Scavo, seconded by Mr. LaCarrubba, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve \$385.60 as an uncollectable debt without any further action.

Approval of Substitute Sign Language Interpreters

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Licata, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve substitute sign language interpreters at a rate of pay of \$40 per hour.

Approval of Budget Transfers Greater Than \$50,000

Upon the recommendation of the Interim Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Licata, seconded by Mr. LaCarrubba, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the following resolution:

Resolved, that the Board of Education approves six budget transfers of \$50,000 or greater. One transfer for \$3,423,587 is to move F Fund salaries to the F Fund Offset budget. One transfer for \$243,874 is to move funds from the East GC code to East site work code for Phase 1 EXCEL Bond Capital Projects for the new fencing installed by Residential Fencing. One transfer for \$350,460 is to allocate funds from the project holding codes for Phase 1 to Phase 2 of the EXCEL Bond Capital Projects for Lynwood, Merrimac and Waverly damaged sink basins and Grundy zone dampers. One transfer for \$100,000 is to allocate funds from the projects for new fencing at North High School. One transfer for \$1,936,400 is to balance the F Fund Offset Code. The sixth transfer for \$599,345.51 is for SSDEU contractual obligation.
