## 1.a. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Association for the</u> <u>Help of Retarded Children (AHRC)</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Timo, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the contract between Sachem Central School District and Association for the Help of Retarded Children (AHRC), Suffolk County Chapter, to provide for the education of handicapped children in special classes to the students enrolled in the program. The cost for this service for each child is the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

## 1.b. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Developmental</u> <u>Disabilities Institute</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a Motion was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Timo, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement

between Sachem Central School District and Developmental Disabilities Institute to provide an educational program for handicapped children at the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. Psychological evaluations shall be paid at a cost of \$500 per evaluation. The term of this contract shall be from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

## 1.c. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and The Devereux</u> <u>Foundation</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Timo, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and The Devereux Foundation to provide for the education of handicapped children in special classes to the students enrolled in the program. ## Approval of Budget Transfers Greater Than \$50,000
