Mini Contracts

<u>Approval of Agreements Between Sachem Central School District and Patchogue-Medford</u> <u>Union Free School District.</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Duncan, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Patchogue-Medford Union Free School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in the Sachem Central School District. The rate for this service is \$603.31 per student. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

b <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and the Riverhead</u> <u>Central School District</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Duncan, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Riverhead Central School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in the Sachem Central School District. The rate for this service is \$599.43 per student. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

c Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Bilinguals, Inc.

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Duncan, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Bilinguals, Inc. to provide services of licensed and qualified occupational therapists, speech pathologists, special educators and psychologists to students with handicapping conditions. The fees per evaluation are as follows:

This will be paid through the Office of Student Services. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

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d <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Special</u> <u>Education Providers for Section 611 and Section 619 Grants</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Duncan, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreements for receipt of IDEA Flow-Through Funding between Sachem Central School District and AHRC-NYSARC, Inc. Suffolk Chapter, East Islip PreSchool Program Early Childhood Center and the Opportunity Pre-School as special education providers for the 611 and 619 grants. The costs associated are in accordance with the IDEA section 611 and section 619 federal funds consistent with federal and state statutes. The term of these agreements shall be September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 for a ten (10) month program or July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 for a twelve (12) month program. These contracts have been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

<u>Approval of Workers' Compensation and Employee Benefit Accrued Liability Reserves to Fund</u> <u>Workers' Compensation Claims</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Sachem Central School District does hereby elect to utilize approximately \$2,000,000 Workers' Compensation Reserve and approximately \$500,000 Employee Benefit Accrued Liability Reserve to fund Workers' Compensation claims and payments to individuals terminating or retiring from service from resources accumulated in the Workers' Compensation Reserve and the Employee Benefit Accrued Liability Reserve. The exact amount will be determined when the June 2011 external audit is completed.

- c. Transportation Issues A memo dated 3/1/11 entitled "March 2, 2011 Board of Education Meeting Transportation Discussion" was discussed. There was a leaning by the Board to maintain the 25 mile out of district transportation to private and parochial schools and to hold firm on the April 1 deadline for out of district transportation requests.

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d. Equipment Requests - A chart entitled "2011-2012 General Fund Equipment Requests" was reviewed. The Board requested an updated list of those items only absolutely necessary for health and safety.
