Associate Superintendent Bruce Singer reviewed his memo to the Board and Superintendent dated 3/27/12 on the subject "March 28, 2012 Board of Education Meeting – 2012/13 Budget Discussion."

The recent budget expenditure and revenue changes were discussed. The final State Aid numbers will be available within the next few days. The new Tax Cap Levy laws were highlighted as well as the consequences of a defeated budget. A question and answer period followed. With a 4.233% weighted tax increase, the budget will require a 60% voter approval. There was a consensus of the Board to add five secondary teachers back into the budget

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A report was requested on managing athletic teams within the current budget but adding teams on an as-needed basis if feasible. The number of students trying out for each middle school sport, the number of students cut, and the costs to run each team were requested to be available at the next Board meeting,
